Subject: Annual Water Report - 2012

This report summarizes the water quality for the year ending December 31, 2012.

With the exception of the north side of the Nechako River, which is served by a private water purveyor and our rural outlying areas, the municipality has a comprehensive network of watermains to service our customers.

The municipality obtains its water supply from two (2) deep artesian wells located at 249 Victoria Street East, immediately adjacent our Water Treatment Plant.

Following treatment, water is pumped through transmission mains to our two (2) water reservoir sites on Hunter Lane (116,148 imp gal) and Nechako Avenue (499,560 imp gal).
