

# Parks Beautification and Campground Students Seasonal Positions (Up to 10 positions)



Reporting to the Director of Community Services, the Parks Beautification and Campground students will perform daily maintenance of all parks and greenspace including mowing, weed eating, gardening, watering, mulching which includes the operation of small machinery; will perform campground attendant duties, such as answering and responding to campground inquiries, taking reservations, checking guests in and out, collecting camping fees, cleaning washroom and the shower house, emptying garbage and campground site cleaning and maintenance; will assist in setup/takedown at District events and other related duties. This is a 40 hour per week position, working rotating day, afternoon, and weekend shifts, at a rate of \$19.80 per hour, from approximately May 2 to September 3, 2022. This position(s) is subject to funding.

- Ability to perform rigorous outdoor physical work in inclement weather
- Knowledge of parks and recreation policies, programs, and regulations

- Demonstrated communication skills & ability to function in a team environment
- Knowledge of Occupational Health and Safety standards

- Be willing to submit to and pass a criminal record check
- Possess strong oral and written communication skills
- Be a self-motivated team player
